# DayTripper's Guide to Day Trips at Mont Tremblant

## Bus/Equipment/Lunch and Après Ski Info

**All participants will be required to wear masks during the Bus trip.**

Bus is a washroom-equipped Luxury Coach.

Some of our members are sensitive to strong perfumes. Please avoid wearing perfume or cologne or using strongly-scented laundry products.

Although not required - a ski or board bag is highly recommended.

Boots can be brought on the bus - but space is limited and for safety reasons - CANNOT be placed in the overhead bins.

Ski and Board Boots must not be put on in the bus

Items may be left on the bus - but - are NOT accessible during the day.

Storage lockers presently are available both at the base of the mountain in Le Chalet des Voyageurs and at the top of the mountain in Le Grand Manitou; check with Mont Tremblant for availability. Plan to leave extra clothing, boots, etc. on bus.

Packed lunches may be stored or eaten in the Chalet des Voyageurs and in designated areas of the Le Grand Manitou and the Chalet du Nord (at the base of the North side); Check with Mont Tremblant for availability.

There are numerous cafeteria and restaurant options.

It is recommended equipment be locked when not in use.

Ski racks are located at all lodges and in the Pedestrian Village.

### Departure from Ottawa/Gatineau

\*\*\*All Participants will be required to present Covid Passport AND Government Identification with Photo to the Trip Leader before the Trip Leader can permit them to enter the bus.\*\*\*

Bus departs Ottawa at 06:30hrs sharp from the Canadian Tire parking lot (Address: 330 Coventry Rd, Ottawa, ON K1K 4S3); Bus will be in place shortly after 06:00hrs.

Cars left in the parking lot must display a parking pass (included with your trip confirmation message).

Enforcement by bylaw officers is strict and the fine is approx \$70.00.

Park in the area indicated in your confirmation message or as directed by the Trip Leader.

The bus arrives at the Carrefour du Versant plaza at 740 Montée Paiement in Gatineau (exit 145 off Highway 50) at about approx 06:50hrs;

If boarding in Gatineau; you must be waiting outside the Pharmacie Familiprix at 06:45hrs. The bus does not wait.

No-shows will be charged for the bus portion of the trip.

MASKS AND/OR FACE COVERINGS ARE MANDATORY FOR ENTRANCE TO MANY GOODS AND SERVICES INCLUDING GONDOLA AND LIFTS

Bus arrives at the South Side of Mont Tremblant at approx 08:45hrs.

Two - three volunteers in the group carefully unload the equipment and place it on the far side of the walkway..

**At Present there are three important changes to the usual arrival:**

- 1. Participants are now allowed to change in the Chalet des Voyageurs!**
- 2. Bags can now be left in the Chalet des Voyageurs, but members may choose to leave bags and extra clothing, etc., on the bus (not accessible during the day).**
- 3. All participants must process through the Chalet des Voyageurs to have their Covid passport and ID validated, in order to ensure smooth access to the hill from the Cabriolet.**

To those with ski tickets, remember to tear off and save the bottom section of your lift ticket (enables replacement if lost).

Tremblant offers a wide variety of dining and après ski opportunities.

Some members participate in a "drop-in" lunch in the box lunch area of the Chalet du Nord (at the base of the North side.)

For après ski beverages and conversations, many members have their own favorite spots (in the pedestrian village.) BUT don't forget the bus departure at 16:30hrs sharp!

In case of emergency, contact the Trip Leader(or ask the ski patrol to do it for you).

Be mindful of lift closing times when skiing the North Side in the afternoon; North Side lifts close earlier.

Ensure sufficient time to get back to the South Side at the end of the day.

### Departure - Mont Tremblant

Bus departs at 16:30hrs sharp; Bus will be in place shortly after 16:00hrs.

Be at the bus well in advance in order to pack and load your gear.

One cargo area will be designated for Gatineau - ensure your gear is in the correct cargo area.

Please take the same seat for the return trip.

Trip Leader will pass the hat for gratuities (totally voluntary) for the driver.

### Arrival in Gatineau/Ottawa

Bus arrives in Gatineau at approx 18:30hrs and in Ottawa at approx 18:50hrs (depending on weather and road conditions).

In Ottawa, as at Mont Tremblant, we ask that 2-3 passengers unload the equipment; and
