The powder in Utah is legendary. Numerous ski areas are in the immediate vicinity boasting the best conditions in the world: altitude of 11,000 feet, an average temperature between 20 and 25 degrees F., snowfalls of 500 to 550 inches.

Ski Venues: The tentative plan includes Alta, Snowbird, and one more as a minimum - plus possible visits to Snowbasin, Park City, or Solitude. Our Guide will suggest the best possible destination each day.

Note: Alta does not allow snowboards so snowboarders will be dropped off at Snowbird. Alta and Snowbird are adjacent hills (think of Whistler/Blackcomb)

Accommodation: Crystal Inn and Suites

Crystal Inn and Suites is conveniently located in downtown Salt Lake City, 10 minutes from Salt Lake City Airport and is close to restaurants, shopping and entertainment. It is also the headquarters of our guide, Normand Perrier.

The hotel features: Rooms and suites with king or queen bed, Refrigerator, Micro-wave oven, Iron and ironing board, Coffee maker, 3 telephones with data port and voice mail, radio alarm clock,

DVD loans at front desk, hair dryer, fitness centre, indoor heated pool, sauna, whirlpool, restaurant, meeting facilities, laundry facility, 24 hour convenience store, and free wireless internet access

Day Transportation:

A private bus will shuttle us to the mountains (30-40 minutes) depending upon destination chosen that morning by our guide. There will be one outgoing bus in the morning and one returning bus in the afternoon.

Other info:

-Payment: Cheque made out to "Voyages Gendron" or credit card but no discount for cheques.

-We have only 28 spots because of bus size limitations. With increased demand, a second bus may be booked.

-Secure parking for 7 nights is available at the ski club office.
