CADS is a not-for-profit organization that offers an adaptive alpine ski and snowboarding program for skiers and boarders with disabilities in the National Capital Region. Programs are run in the following NCR locations: Camp Fortune, Edelweiss, and Mont Cascades in Que and Mount Packenham and Calabogie Peaks in Ontario. Over 200 people are registered in their programs and more than 300 volunteers providing adaptive snow sport opportunities and instruction in these programs. Programs run on weekends in January and February and costs are minimal and equipment is provided.

If you have an interest in helping others and have skiing/boarding experience at the intermediate level or higher, they would very much like to see you. The experience is amazing, you ski for free and get great ski improvement instruction, (CADS will support your Canadian Ski Instructor Alliance training).
